Solvent Based Shelter Primer

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

ARDEX WPM 240 (Shelter Primer) is a solvent based primer to be used to seal and prepare the substrate prior to the installation of the Shelterbit torch-on and Shelterseal self adhesive membranes.

APPLICATION

Ensure that the surface to be primed is dry and free from dust, oil, paint, curing compounds and any other contaminating materials. Stir contents well before use. Apply by brush, roller or airless spray. ARDEX WPM 240 (Shelter Primer) must be dry before applying membrane.

COVERAGE

1 Litre of ARDEX WPM 240 (Shelter Primer) will cover approximately $5 \, \mathrm{m}^2$.

DRYING TIME

Allow 1-2 hours at 23°C.

LIMITATIONS

ARDEX WPM 240 (Shelter Primer) should be used with appropriate mask and breathing apparatus in areas with poor ventilation/air flow.

PACKAGING

5L and 20L

STORAGE

12 Months in the original unopened packaging stored at 23°C.

IDENTIFICATION

ARDEX WPM 240 is available in a Clear and Black liquid.

Wash equipment with ARDEX WA98S.
